Mitzie Recalls Her Experience at Grace Pointe's Rehabilitation Center

Q: Tell us a little bit about your care needs that brought you to Grace Pointe's Rehabilitation Center

I broke my shoulder, ribs, and elbow and was in a lot of pain, but they were very accommodating day and night. I had trouble getting comfortable and no matter who was in the room they would always adjust me. That level of care and their presence made a huge difference in my progress.

Q: Tell us about the physical care you received while at Grace Pointe

My therapists were incredible - all three of them! When I first got to Grace Pointe, we started out mostly walking, and I didn't even get to do that in the hospital. I had only stood up one time at the hospital, and that was to leave. Shortly after starting therapy at Grace Pointe, we did balancing and strengthening exercises. They even did exercises so that I could come home and cook - which I've done every day since I've been back! I was able to go at my own pace and everyone was so patient. Only a week after I started therapy I was able to go all the way to the end of the hall, and that felt so good because I'm a walker!

Q: What made Grace Pointe a special place to you?

I joke that I 'adopted' one of the team members! Lauren is my new adopted daughter. She was just so sweet, she would braid my hair and went above and beyond to make me comfortable. Whatever I needed, every time she came to my room she did way more than I would have ever asked for. She was a doll, I just love her! Whether

it was Lauren spending time with me exchanging our favorite family photos or others just stopping in to talk to me it was just those connections that made it so personal.

Q: How did Grace Pointe help you stay connected during your stay?

I was at Grace Pointe for two weeks over the holidays. My kids did a video call with me on Christmas, and I'm not technical but Grace Pointe set it all up so I could be a part of the whole Christmas and watch my family open presents! I was so emotional over it that I couldn't fully interact but it was so fun. I thought, "this must be what it's like to be in heaven" where you can just sit back and see all the good going on.

Q: Overall, how was your experience at Grace Pointe?

My experience at Grace Pointe was amazing. The entire staff, right down to the cleaning (team), were always kind, helpful, and cheerful. Everyone every step of the way was so attentive to me. How Our 'Air Scrubber' System Addresses Needs & Achieves Care

A Message from Erik Briscoe, Second-Generation Owner, and Director of Business Development at Grace Pointe Having been raised in this community and knowing the residents and families at the highest risk, we take our responsibility to maintain the best environment possible for our residents very seriously. While we have implemented the highest level of sanitization and social distancing practices at Grace Pointe, studies show that shared air (HVAC) systems make it possible to spread illnesses.

At Grace Pointe, we recently installed a Needlepoint Bipolar Ionization (NPBI) air purification system at our campus to fight against the airborne transmission of illnesses, such as COVID-19 and the flu. By investing in this cutting edge whole-building air scrubbing system, we are addressing the need of better air quality for every member of our care community.

We chose NPBI as a solution to our shared air concerns because it has been tested and proven to destroy COVID-19. In an independent study, needlepoint bi-polar ionizers were placed inside of a room where coronavirus patients had been housed. Within 10 minutes, the ionizers destroyed 99.4 percent of the coronavirus particles in the air and 80 percent of surface-living particles.

Outside of the current overwhelmingly urgent need, this system will benefit the wellbeing of our residents and staff by better addressing air-quality for years to come. Our family and company continually assess needs to achieve the highest quality in every aspect of care we deliver to residents — including the research and adoption of industry-leading technologies — and will continue to do so long after the threat of COVID-19 subsides.

Grace Pointe COVID Vaccine Clinics

Grace Pointe received 6 COVID Vaccine clinics under the CARES Act with the vaccine being administered free of charge and on a priority basis between the beginning of January and the end of February.



On January 2, 2021 we held our first vaccine clinic for staff and skilled/rehab residents!



We exceeded our goal of 80% of the staff having received the vaccine. In total, 91% of staff received their vaccination.



98% of the residents have received their COVID-19 Vaccine.

What is the Mission of the Alzheimer's Association?
